

Dr Setumo Mohapi joins the State Information Technology Agency as CEO

TSHWANE – Today (01 April 2015), Dr. Setumo Mohapi assumed duty officially as the new Chief Executive Officer of the State Information Technology Agency (SITA), taking over from Mr. Freeman Nomvalo whose contract with the organization came to end on 31 March 2015.

This follows the announcement made by the Cabinet on 18 March 2015 among others that Dr. Setumo Mohapi has been appointed to the State Owned Company for a four year term effective 01 April and will run until 31 March 2019.
