Partnerships cut developmental costs, shorten lead times for everyone.



Entrepreneurship in South Africa

We are not as good as we think



 The Global Entrepreneurship Index (GEI) which measure entrepreneurship capacity, places South Africa 53rd out of 130 countries participating



 South Africa is operating at 40% of its entrepreneurial capacity (with the world as a whole at 52%).

Looking at on the ground experiences reported by SA Institute for Entrepreneurship (SAIE) and comparing that to Global Entrepreneurship Monitor (GEM) stats, South Africa is in fact, **not an entrepreneurial nation**.

The potential

According to the SAIE, the areas where we can improve the most are in **start-up skills and human capital development**

With human capital development being low in South this provides wonderful opportunity for improvement and growth through entrepreneurship development.

If we can develop a vibrant entrepreneurial culture, SA could become a winning nation – one that is an entrepreneurial role model to the rest of Africa.

It is essential that we foster a more enabling business environment, particularly for the small and medium-sized enterprises which contribute so much to employment.

In many developing economies, small businesses have been shown to contribute substantially to job creation, economic growth and more equal income distribution.


