Purpose of the job

To job will be responsible to: assist the company to minimize information or cybersecurity risks being undertaken in performing operational, financial, and technological business processes assessment; assist management/ risk owners to define the scope, identify, understand, and manage risks tangled with their operations; and provide leadership with necessary capacity to improve their internal security controls along with information security assessment frameworks aligned to enterprise/corporate risk management.

Key Responsibility Areas

- Develop information risk methodology and processes for operational risks assessment and treatment.
- Assist management to identify, understand, and manage risks tangled with their operations.
- Partner with clients and all SITA divisions and departments (risk owners) and to ensure risk management execution.
- Provide advisory support on information risk mitigation, data protection techniques, vendor management, leverage on existing legal structures and practices to ensure compliance with regulations, policies, processes and procedures.
- Facilitation of compliance information risks identification including analyzing policies, laws and regulations.
- Track, oversee incident investigations and facilitate remediations of the information risks across SITA managed networks including the clients when required to ensure effective controls.

Qualifications and Experience

Minimum: 3-year National Higher Diploma/bachelor's degree in information Risk Management/Auditing/Information Systems or Finance, Compliance or any relevant qualification equivalent to the NQF Level.

Certification: Professional IT security management or risk certification e.g. ITIL Foundation, COBIT 2019 foundation, IT Risk Fundamental, CompTIA Security+, GSEC, CRISC, CISA, IRAM2 foundation, ISO 27005 Risk Manager will be an added advantage.

Experience: 6-7 years' experience in Information or Cybersecurity (including Data Privacy) Risk Management, Internal Audit and/or Compliance management. Experience must include: experience in consulting either internal or external; experience in performing information risk assessments following industry standards identifying inherent information or cybersecurity risk and tracking information or cybersecurity schedule risk.
