Requirements for candidates to be eligible for selection for a course:

- Basic computer literacy;
- Basic PC operating system navigation skills;
- Basic Internet usage skills; and/or
- Comptia Networks plus (Applicable only to Cisco CCNA & Huawei HCIA).
