Purpose of the job

The Release Manager plays a critical role in ensuring the smooth and efficient delivery of software releases, enabling organizations to deliver value to customers more rapidly and reliably. Manage all changes that impact on IT's ability to deliver services through a formal, centralised process of approval, to ensure that the IT infrastructure stays aligned to business requirements with a minimum of risk and also provide the configuration information to all users to prevent faults occurring due to incorrectly configured items and pursue operational excellence.

Key Responsibility Area

- Ensure that communication regarding approved changes and release notes are distributed to all stakeholders in order to maintain optimum service level agreements.
- Provide input to the IT release process for all environments in order to track IT changes from different environments to minimize production discrepancies.
- Implement the IT Change Control process to maximise consistencies in service delivery.
- Maintains the Definitive Software Library (DSL) and CMDB of all applications within production, testing and QA
 to enhance optimum systems performance.
- Implement and review the process by which licenses are reconciled to deployment in order to identify and report on compliance exposures and facilitate the process of obtaining maximum compliance standards.
- Implement, review and maintain the Release Management process.

Certification: ITIL Practitioner Certificate is required. Advanced DevOps and Agile Project Management is an added advantage.
